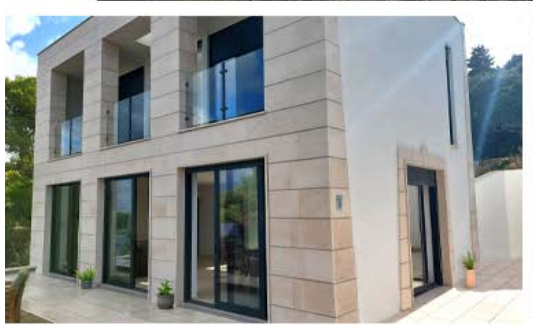

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House Etiquette & Info

Please respect the following requests so that we can keep the house looking it's best for future guests.

No wet bums on indoor seats!

We kindly ask that you don't use the indoor seating in wet swim suits.

Nothing other than toilet paper down the toilet. We are on an island and the drainage is good but delicate so we kindly remind you that nothing other than toilet paper is to be flushed down the toilets.

Using and rinsing of padel boards and kayaks. The equipment is there for you to use but we ask that you take care to use as it should be and that the padel boards especially are rinsed after each use to keep them from salt damage.

Gym equipment is also there for you to use at your own risk. We just ask that you wipe it down after use.

Leaving the house. We ask that at the end of your stay you leave the house as clean and tidy as you found it for the next guests.

Shutters are electric and controlled via switches on the walls.

You're welcome to use anything in the house. The cupboard in the dining room has beach and house games you are welcome to use.

House books, please help yourself, all we ask as if you take one home to finish you leave one in its place.

Bins

Blue = Cardboard/Paper **Yellow** = Plastic/Metals
Grey Dumpster = Glass **Brown** = Organic Waste
Green = Residual Waste

Please empty all bins when departing.

Splitska

Splitska is a small village with a local shop for groceries, fresh bread in the mornings, sells most essentials. Also sells coal and lighter fluid if you would like to use the BBQ.

There are 3 restaurants in the bay

All are very good but during high season are very busy so I would advise booking the day before to ensure a table. There is also a cafe bar Skalinada with beautiful view, but please note the bar only takes cash.

Restoran Vala

A lovely fish and meat restaurant, does great steaks, Vala is a 5 minute walk from the villa.

Konoba Kod Tonča is located at Riva 16 in Splitska on the island of Brač, right by the sea, making it one of the most desirable places to dine with a view of the harbour and bay. Surrounding Areas

Local Beach

The beach (5 minute walk) has a beach bar with Wi-Fi, as with all beaches on the island they tend to get busier after lunch so if you prefer quiet the morning is the time for the beaches. We usually sunbath and swim by the rocks in the afternoon (steps down to the rocks are just in from of the house, it's also the best place to access the water with paddle boards or kayaks).

Nearby Villages

There are plenty of other villages that are worth a visit.

Supetar

This is the place to be if your looking for a day trip, most go from here. You can also hire off road buggies from here.

There is an open air cinema called Kino Mediteranean which will have English films showing at different times, sells snacks and isn't expensive.

There is also the water activities hidden around the far side of Supetar bay are the water inflatable rides and water sports.



Postira

It's possible to walk to postira by following the path all around the bay it's around a 50 minute flat walk but worth a trip

There are inflatables there and a fantastic cocktail bar right on the beach called Inkognito bar. It's also possible to kayak to postira if your prepared for a work out!



Sutivan

Around a 15 minute drive past Supetar

The town is lovely and has a great beach with a very large swimming area. There are plenty of lovely restaurants and a fantastic little cake shop which is definitely worth a visit.



Bol

A lively day out on the south side of the island around a 50 minute drive through the centre of the island great for water sports and it's famous Zlatni rat beach. The old town there has a market and a winery and is a little quieter, there is a taxi boat that goes between the old town and the main beach if you don't want to walk.

Pučišća

This village is around a 15 minute drive from the house and a lovely place for lunch it's the home of the Stone masonry school, there are a number of great restaurants around the bay.

Car Hire, Ferry & Taxi

Carr Hire

Hire cars can be rented from Split airport before travelling or when you arrive. Split airport is small and very easy to navigate. Car rentals are only a 5 minute walk from arrivals. If you hire a car, the ferry port is roughly a 25 minute drive away.

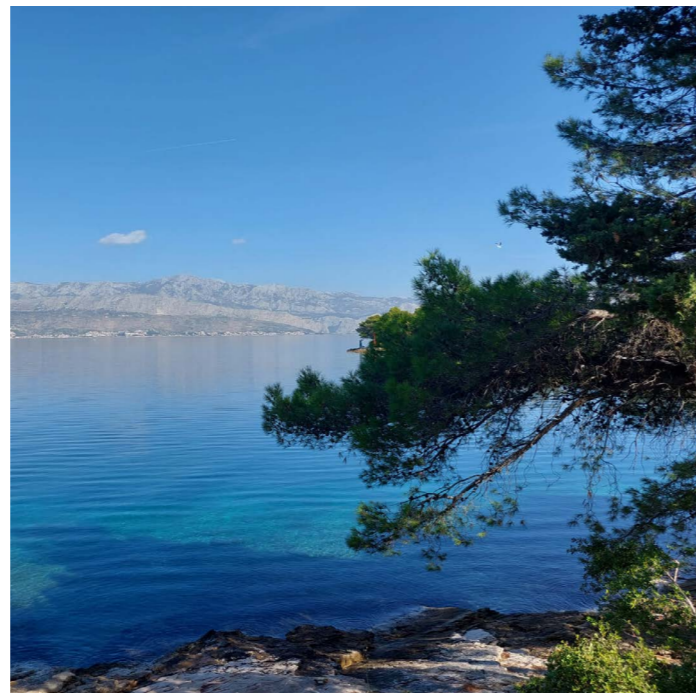
Ferry Port

When at the Ferry port you need to head to the queuing area for Supetar. The ferry's work on a first come first served basis so when you arrive and park you are not guaranteed to get on the first one in high season but they are very regular so you shouldn't have to wait too long. The same is relevant on the return journey so please leave extra time when travelling back to the airport.

Tickets can be bought online in advance or at the ticket office at the ferry port.
